Cuckoo (Cacomantis flabelliformis) was seen on 22nd May. Rufous Whistlers (Pachycephala rufiventris), which usually appear to leave, have been there since last spring. A number of Sparrows (Passer domesticus) have been noticed eating the buds of the Soursob (Oxalis). On a visit to Milang in February last two Marsh Terns (Chlidonias leucopareia), were observed. One was in adult, and the other in immature, plumage. A Grey Teal (Quarquedula gibberifrons) was seen to dive in about eight feet of water and bring up a yabbie, which she crushed and gave to two young birds.
