YELLOW-TAILED BLACK COCKATOO (Calyptorhynchus funereus).

A flock of fifteen was seen at Yankalilla, several flocks of about thirty birds each were noted near Normanville, and a flock of thirty was seen near Second Valley Forest Reserve, while at Delamere a large flock of over fifty birds was seen. The birds were roosting in pinetrees in each case. (11th October). H. T. CONDON.
