CRESTED PIGEON (Ocyphaps lophotes).

First seen here December 26, 1928, one bird only. Not seen again until January 1, 1931, when two birds appeared. Were here at odd times through 1931 and 1932 in numbers of from 1 to 15.

First nest found here February 9, 1933, since then numbers of nests have been found in all months of the year and every year since 1933. At present they are common here in small flocks of 20 to 50. This year one pair that we have near the homestead used the same nest to bring out two clutches of two.
