

BIRDS OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA

It is now nearly twenty years since the last complete list of birds recorded from South Australia was published in 1927 by the late John Sutton (6). Although many corrections and additions have appeared in the pages of this journal from time to time, it is thought that Sutton's original list reprinted and "brought up to date" would be useful in many ways. All amendments to the original list have been carefully checked, and 21 further native species have been added to Sutton's original 369; five have been deleted, making a total of 385. A list of introduced species is also appended.

Nomenclature and sequence is that of the R.A.O.U. Official Checklist of the Birds of Australia (1926 edition) (1) together with amendments made in the Checklist Committee Reports Nos. 1, 2, and 3 (2) (3) (4). Figures in parentheses after the vernacular names refer to the consecutive number of the species in the R.A.O.U. list.
