Willie Wagtail (Rhipidura leucophrys)—On the afternoon of October 28, 1949, at Beaumont, two Willie Wagtails were attacking a domestic cat which was crouching not far from their nest. After several attacks and much chaftering, one of the Wagtails fluttered across the path some distance from the cat and leading away from it, doing the "injured bird" trick, a rare thing with such an aggressive bird.—J. B. Cleland.
