

BIRD NOTES

TWO NEW RECORDS AT NARACOOORTE WHITE-THROATED WARBLER

Near midday on Saturday, February 7, 1965, J.B.H. was walking through one of the parks in the centre of the town, when he heard a strange bird calling from a flowering *Lagunaria*. After searching for some minutes a White-throated Warbler (*Gerygone olivacea*) was located busily feeding on insects among the blossom.

On the following Monday A.R.A. saw the bird still feeding in the same tree, but further visits on succeeding days failed to find the Warbler. It is realised that this is only a sight record of a very small bird, but as both observers are familiar with this species in Queensland, we have no hesitation in recording the occurrence of this warbler in S.A.
