A POCKET LIST OF AUSTRALIAN BIRDS compiled by P. J. Fullagar for the A.C.T. Branch, R.A.O.U., 20 pp. Price six for \$1.00 or 20c. each (plus 5c postage).

This is a list of some 760 species (and some easily recognised races) of birds recorded for Australia and Tasmania, including established introductions, designed for use as a 'field card' for keeping basic records when travelling, records of birds of an area, or other similar uses.

Vernacular names only are used, plus five columns about a quarter inch square for the briefest of notes. The order differs from that of the R.A.O.U. Checklist and follows that now generally accepted by most authorities. The names themselves vary in a number of cases from those of the Checklist; the new names often being a distinct improvement, and on the whole are definitely to be preferred to many of the new vernaculars used in recent editions of Cayley's What Bird is That?
