MEMBERSHIP BY GIBBERON CHECKS

During 1966 there occurred a spectacular outbreak of Gibberon Check from the southern area of South Australia. It is intended to publish a paper on this occurrence in the next issue of this journal and so much information as possible is required on this and previous outbreaks elsewhere in Victoria. In particular, information is required on:-

1. Date of arrival and departure,

2. Nature of feeding ground,

3. Nature of feeding—does, can they, drink
water, etc., etc.

4. How far south, east and west the birds
migrated and

5. Possible reasons for the migration.

Further reports on unusual numbers of the other species of check, or of any other species of check would also be welcomed.
