VOICES OF THE AUSTRALIAN BUSH,  
by Harold J. Pollock, published by the  
Jacaranda Press, 1970, 26 pp., plus a 7"  
45 R.P.M. E.P. recording. Price \$2.95.

The second in this series by H. J. Pollock follows the same pattern as presented in the previous edition, with the exception that both sides of the record are devoted to bird calls. There is thus a total of thirty-nine calls, all of which are of very good quality. However the calls appear somewhat crowded. I feel that if the birds were introduced in a few well chosen words by a professional commentator, the record would have much more popular appeal. It would then become a pleasure to listen to many times over.
