270. WELCOME SWALLOW (357)

Bolivar (AP), 300+, several hundred, 500+ and 1000+ on Aug. 29, Dec. 29, Jan. 8 and June 7 resp.; smaller numbers at other times (B.G.).

Bolivar (AP), 100+ and several thousand on Dec. 29 and Jan. 29 resp., I.C.I. Saltfields (AP), several hundred on Feb. 27 (B.G.); Port Augusta (LN) 100+ flying through and about a garden sprinkler on Feb. 18 (M.M.).

Small numbers recorded Waukaringa (LN), Cooper Ck and Yankaninna (NE) (sev. obs.).

312-3. GROUND-WRENS (489, 499)

Salt Ck (MM), birds seen with and without white wing spots; both Chestnuttailed and Shy Ground-Wrens believed to be present, Oct. 10-12 (S.A.O.A. campout).

314. STRIATED FIELD-WREN (500) Lake Bonney (SE), recorded Jan. 31 (D.A.E. excn).

*317. WESTERN GRASS-WREN (510)
Whyalla area (EP), recorded July 14 and
Sept. 21—some with young (G.R.).

*319. THICK-BILLED GRASS-WREN (512)

Fifteen miles NE of Leigh Ck (NE), 3 on Aug. 13 (J.M.S.); Leigh Ck (NE), 2 young dead in nest, apparently of malnutrition due to severe drought, Aug. 16 (G.R.).

320. STRIATED GRASS-WREN (513)
Gluepot (LN), common, Oct. 11-12
(J.E.); Glenburr Scrub (MM), 2 on March
12 in *Triodia* in mallee country (J.C.);
also recorded Pooginook Reserve (MM),
Peebinga Nat. Pk (MM) and 3 miles SW
of Chapman Bore (MM) (sev. obs.).

*321. SOUTHERN EMU-WREN (526)
Two miles north of Vivonne Bay (KI),
8+ on Jan. 13, believed to be this species
(A.L.); Finniss (MM), still plentiful (J.E.);

Policeman Point, Coorong, 6 on Jan. 16 (J.C.); Messent Nat. Pk (MM), recorded Oct. 10-12 (S.A.O.A. campout); Beachport (SE), recorded Jan. 16-22 and March 6-8 (D.A.E. excns).

324. SUPERB BLUE-WREN (529)

Eleven miles south of Pinnaroo (MM), 2 miles south of Jabuk (MM), recorded Oct. 17 (J.E.). See Eckert, J. (1972c).

*329. BLUE-BREASTED WREN (540) South Block, near Coulta (EP), 2 on Nov. 11 (M.C., R.W.C.).

337. SCARLET ROBIN (380)

Telowie Gorge (LN), one on Aug. 8 (D.A.E. excn), and Aug. 20 (B.G.).

338. RED-CAPPED ROBIN (381)

W.R.E. Salisbury (AP), 2 females or juveniles, Sept. 28 (M.C., R.W.C.); Altona Scrub (MLR), recorded Sept. 27 (S.A.O.A. excn).

339. FLAME ROBIN (382)

Recorded between April 16—2 miles south of Ashbourne (MLR) (P.S.), and Aug. 14—Mannum (MM), one female (J.C.); other records from Mount Compass and Macclesfield (MLR) and 10.5 miles NW of Wynarka, and Finniss River (MM) (sev. obs.).

340A. ROSE ROBIN (384)

Beaumont (AP), one on June 13, 14, 15, 19, 20 and 22 (J.P.).

343. GOLDEN WHISTLER (398)

Millswood (AP), a female singing on April 26 (J.S.).

*345. RED-LORED WHISTLER (402)
Thirty miles north of Waikerie (MM),

pair feeding 2 young on Oct. 11 (S.N.C. excn); also recorded Bunn's Bore (MM) (J.E.). See Eckert, J. (1972d).

*347. OLIVE WHISTLER (405)

Beachport (SE), recorded in Jan. and March (D.A.E. excns).

349. EASTERN SHRIKE-TIT (416)

Millswood (AP), one on Dec. 15 and Jan. 5 (J.S.); Leabrook (AP), 2 on March 15 (R.B.); Panorama (AP), recorded June 9 (N.C.); Clare (LN), 2 on Jan. 16 (G.L.).

351. WEDGEBILL (420)

Olary and Mannahill (LN), c.100—common bird of water-courses and gullies, Jan. 31 (K.M.).

352. WESTERN WHIPBIRD (422)

Pondalowie Bay area (YP), several records in Sept. (sev. obs.).

*355. RUFOUS TREE-CREEPER (556)
Kimba (EP), pair with young Sept. 22
(G.R.); recorded in a narrow strip of
country from north of Wirregenda to Lake
Gibbs (EP) (G.L.).

*357. WHITE-BROWED

Canegrass Stn (LN), numerous Sept. 5 (G.R.); Balah and Gluepot (LN), numerous (J.E.); 10 miles upstream from Renmark (MM), 2 on Aug. 30 (D.V.); Woolpunda (MM), one on Oct. 19 (M.T.); north of Blanchetown area (MM), one on April 12 (E.A., M.J.A.).

*366. BLACK HONEYEATER (589)

Lilydale Stn (LN), 2 on Oct. 12 (K.M.); 6 miles NE of Berri (MM), 4 and 6 on Oct. 19 and 21 resp.; 2 pairs nesting (R.G.), SW of Waikerie (MM) 12 on Oct. 20 (K.M.), Glenburr Scrub (MM), a male and female on Oct. 11 (J.C.).

*367. PIED HONEYEATER (602)

Gluepot Stn (LN), 2 males on Oct. 11 (J.E.); Lilydale Stn (LN), one female on Oct. 12 (K.M.); 6 miles NE of Berri (MM), 2 on Oct. 21 (R.G.); Glenburr Scrub (MM) one male on Dec. 5 (J.C.); Goyder's Lagoon (NE), 4 males in lignum flats (D.V.); Telichie Dam, Kalabity Stn (NE), 5 on Jan. 31 (K.M.).

368. SINGING HONEYEATER (608)

St Francis Is. Group (EP), very common on all islands, 8-10 in camp area at all times, Jan. 4-12 (P.M.).

*370. YELLOW-FRONTED HONEYEATER (623)

Telowie Gorge (LN), several on Aug. 20 (B.G.); Pooginook Nat. Pk (MM), common on Jan. 11 (J.M.).

379. WHITE-NAPED HONEYEATER (578)

Clare (LN), 2 on Oct. 3, not previously recorded within 20 miles radius (D.P.); Woolpunda (MM), one on Nov. 8 (M.T.).

383. YELLOW-WINGED HONEYEATER (631)

Ashbourne (MLR), a lutino bird recorded Dec. 5 and 12, a partial lutino in March (J.E.).

384. WHITE-FRONTED HONEYEATER (594)

Langhorne Ck (MM), odd birds in Feb. (J.E.); Pondalowie Bay and 11 miles south of Warooka (YP), recorded Sept. 8 and 12 resp. (W.E.A. excn); odd records from upper MM and adjacent LN from July to Oct. (sev. obs.).

386. STRIPED HONEYEATER (585)

Recorded from Gluepot and Lilydale Stns (LN) and Blanchetown, Mannum and Langhorne Ck areas (MM) (sev. obs.).

389. EASTERN SPINEBILL (591)

Mundoora Nat. Pk (LN), one on Aug. 9 (D.A.E. excn).

393. BLUE-FACED HONEYEATER (641)

Mannum (MM), one from Jan. 9 to March (A.T.).

398A. GOLDFINCH (—)

Kingscote to Flinders Chase (KI), numerous Jan. 7-22 (A.L.); Olary Ridge (LN), recorded June 13—the northernmost recording by observer (K.M.).

398B. GREENFINCH (—)

Point Sturt (MM), 2 pairs in June (B.Y.); Strathalbyn area (MM), not uncommon (J.E.).

401. BEAUTIFUL FIRETAIL (650)

Recorded from Snug Cove (KI), Cox's Scrub Nat. Pk and Waitpinga (MLR); Salt Creek (MM), and Robe and Beachport (SE) (sev. obs.).

403. ZEBRA FINCH (653)

Olary Ridge (LN), thousands seen on Jan. 11—very common since 1968-9 (J.M.); Birdsville Track (NE), 100+, July 4-10 (D.V.).

403C. STARLING (---)

Gumeracha (MLR), 1000+ flocking over orchard on Jan. 31 (D.L.).

404. OLIVE-BACKED ORIOLE (671)

Altona Scrub (MLR), 2 on Oct. 4 (E.A., M.J.A.); Blackwood (MLR), 2 on Dec. 31 (L.M.P.); Yilki (MLR), one on May 20 (D.A.E. excn).

*406. APOSTLE BIRD (675)

Lilydale Stn (LN), 12 and 40 on Jan. 2 and 10 resp.; Cadell (MM), 2, nesting, and 10 on Nov. 8 and Feb. 3 resp. (K.M.).

407. WHITE-WINGED CHOUGH (693)

'Anlaby,' Kapunda (LN), 20+ on June 11 (M.G.); Boolgun, 18 miles south of Waikerie (MM), 50 in one group, June 20 (K.M.).

*408. WHITE-BREASTED

WOOD-SWALLOW (543)

Near Moorook (MM), 15 on April 24 (M.O.); Telichie Dam, Kalabity Stn (NE), pair with 3 young, Jan. 31. (K.M.).

*409. MASKED WOOD-SWALLOW (544)

Morgan (MM), 10 on Jan. 1 (K.M.); Mannum (MM), a mixed flock (with Dusky Wood-Swallows) of 200-300 on Oct. 4, Glenburr Scrub (MM), a few on Oct. 12 (J.C.); Langhorne Ck (MM), a few in Oct. and Nov. (J.E.).

*410. WHITE-BROWED

WOOD-SWALLOW (545)

Morgan (MM) to Lilydale (LN), 50 on Jan. 1 (K.M.); Waikerie area (MM), many on Oct. 24-25 (M.A.); Peebinga Nat. Pk (MM), 30 on Nov. 7 (A.J.); Glenburr Scrub (MM), on Oct. 12 seen feeding on nectar from blossoming eucalypts; tops of a few trees covered by these birds plus a few Masked Wood-Swallows (J.C.); Langhorne Ck (MM), small flock Oct. 4, more later but not plentiful; little evidence of nesting (J.E.); Keith (MM), 2 on April 24 (B.G.).

411. BLACK-FACED

WOOD-SWALLOW (546)

Olary Ridge (LN), 100+ on Jan. 31 (K.M.); Lake Plains (MM), present until Aug. 15, returned again May 31 (L.P.).

412. DUSKY WOOD-SWALLOW (547)

Mannum (MM), on Oct. 4 a mixed flock (with Masked Wood-Swallows) of 200-300 spreading over sky, flying east (J.C.).

417. WHITE-BACKED MAGPIE (707)

Recorded as far north as 5 miles NE of Berri (MM) (R.G.), and north of Hawker (NE) (B.G.).

421. LITTLE RAVEN (690e)

Beaumont Common (AP) c.50 on April 25, not normally more than 3 or 4 seen at a time (J.P.); Charleston (MLR), 170+ on Nov. 30 (D.L.).
