

# Bird Report, 2011-2015: Part 2, Passerines

## INTRODUCTION

Part 1 of the Bird Report for 2011-2015, on non-passerines, appeared in the previous issue of the Journal (Carpenter and Horton 2019). Here we provide brief details of passerines recorded in South Australia during 2011-2015, again focussing on records from regions where the species are rare or unrecorded, records outside the 'normal' season for seasonal visitors, records of unusually high numbers of birds or at the limits of a species' range, and breeding records. Sources of records are as detailed in Part 1.

Highlights within the passerines during the 5-year period were new State records in the North East of Tawny Grassbird and Plum-headed Finch, and discovery of the Spotted Bowerbird after a long absence from SA. These followed a period of exceptional rainfall in the region and which also led to a number of interesting passerine records in adjacent parts of south-west Queensland (Jaensch *et al.* 2013). In addition, the revision of the Golden Whistler in mainland southern Australia by Joseph *et al.* (2014) suggests that a new species, the Western Whistler *Pachycephala occidentalis*, could occur in SA based on a report of an uncoloured bird in May 1996 in the far south-west of SA by Carpenter and Mathew (1997).

Nomenclature, list order and regions follow the Birds SA *Field List of the Birds of South Australia* (Blaylock *et al.* 2020). Reports submitted to and confirmed by the Birds SA South Australian

Rarities Committee are identified by (SARC) together with the SARC report number. Images are included of several of the birds listed in this report. Most were taken with the aim of providing proof of identification, and illustrate that for rare bird records any photographs displaying diagnostic features are valuable; aesthetic quality is of no importance in this context.
