The following species were noted on 11th April, 1926, at five miles south-east of Cape Jervis and towards Victor Harbour:—*Phalacrocorax varius*, Pied Cormorant; *Larus novae-hollandiae*, Silver Gull; *Uroaetus audax*, Wedge-tailed Eagle (4); *Falco longipennis*, Little Falcon (1); *Falco cenchroides*, Nankeen Kestrel (1); *Hirundo neoxena*, Welcome-Swallow; *Hylacola*, Ground-Wren, sp. (?); *Gliciphila melanops*, Tawny-crowned Honey-eater; *Meliornis novae-hollandiae*, Yellow-winged Honey-eater; *Anthochaera carunculata*, Red Wattle-Bird; *Anthus australis*, Australian Pipit; *Corvus ceciliae*, Australian Crow; *Gymnorhina hypoleuca*, White-backed Magpie.
