*Petroica phoenicea*, Flame Robin.—These birds were reported to have arrived in South Australia for the winter months. Mr. S. Sanders saw them at Warradale, Sturt, on 19th April; Mr. J. W. Mellor, at Lockleys on 21st; and Mr. J. Sutton saw two males and a female at Kinchina on 23rd.

*Cuculus pallidus*, Pallid Cuckoo.—Dr. A. M. Morgan reported that one had been seen flying southwards near the main road at one and a half miles south of Port Broughton on the 5th.

*Tribonyx ventralis*, Black-tailed Native Hen.—Mr. George Gurr reported numbers on the Sewage Farm, Islington, up to the 24th, but immediately after the heavy rains on that date these birds disappeared, and *Threskiornis spinicollis*, Straw-necked Ibis, put in an appearance.
