opportunities out there to be more involved, and to get to see who is active on particular issues.

D Paton You must have a goal, rather than being reactionary, be proactive.

S Brealey We need to define our goals.

J Githsam Through education, such as the WEA course, you get conservation.

B Walker Through our web site we see a small but constant dribble of people subscribing to our Newsletter.
