18/10/1928.—Two Budgerygahs (*Melopsittacus undulatus*) were seen flying over the garden at North Adelaide.

4/11/1928.—At Haycock Point, Normanville, there were seen a young Collared Sparrowhawk (*Accipiter cirrocephalus*), which appeared to be just out of the nest; a pair of Galahs (*Kakatoe roseicapilla*); 40 Crows (*Corvus ceciliae*), in a crop of oats. Near Aldinga a flock of about 20 Budgerygahs, then a pair, were seen.
