*Calamanthus isabellinus* (Rusty Field-Wren).—At the beginning of September, 1928, a nest containing three eggs was found in a samphire swamp by the edge of Lake Frome in about the only patch of grass in the district, as there has been no rain for two years.

*Cacomantis flabelliformis* (Fan-tailed Cuckoo).—Eggs of this species of Cuckoo were found in the nests of *Sericornis maculatus* (Spotted Scrub-Wren) at the Grange in July, 1928.
