June 14, 1929.—This morning, about 10.30 a.m., I saw a Red Wattle-Bird (*Anthochaera carunculata*) chasing what appeared to be a Pallid Cuckoo (*Cuculus pallidus*), and having in mind the fact that I saw this species last year some weeks before it was first reported around Adelaide, I made a closer investigation, and found that it was a Pallid Cuckoo. I have noticed several pairs of Ringneck Parrots (*Barnardius barnardi*) inspecting hollows in trees, so evidently nesting-time is near. On 9th inst. two neighbours told me they had seen a Bustard (*Erypodotis australis*) in some stubble. This species is said to be fairly numerous at times about half-way between Coombe and Pinnaroo.
