On the shores of Ewe Island Creek, near the Murray Mouth, the following species were noted on 30th June, 1929:—Red-capped Dotterels (*Charadrius ruficapillus*), in numbers; Red-necked Avocets (*Recurvirostra novae-hollandiae*), between 600 and 700 individuals; Eastern Curlew (*Numenius cyanopus*), one bird only; Greenshank (*Tringa nebularia*), six birds. No Sharp-tailed Sandpipers or Red-necked (Little) Stints were seen.
