22/12/1929.—In the Barossa Ranges, near Williamstown, an Eastern Whiteface (*Aphelocephala leucopsis*) was noted feeding young. Two young Magpie-Larks (*Grallina cyanoleuca*) were seen.

30/12/1929.—At Sellick's Beach. There were very few birds about, but the following were seen:—Brown Hawk (*Falco berigora*), a Golden Whistler (*Pachycephala pectoralis*), Grey Fantails (*Rhipidura flabellifera*), Superb Blue Wrens (*Malurus cyaneus*), and a few Yellow-winged Honeyeaters (*Meliornis novae-hollandiae*).

5/1/1930.—Between Lower Light and Two Wells 25 Banded Plovers (*Zonifer tricolor*) were wading in rainwater puddles a
