On 27th January, 1930, I saw a flock of four, another of 13, and a single bird of Yellow-tailed Black Cockatoos (*Calyptorhynchus funereus*) at a pine forest (*Pinus insignis*) near Myponga.

Galah (*Kakatoe roseicapilla*).—A month ago a single bird was flying about Glen Osmond until 22nd January; then five were seen about until 13th February, when only three were seen.

Budgerygah (*Melopsittacus undulatus*).—On 7th February one bird was seen following a Purple-crowned Lorikeet (*Glossopsitta porphyrocephala*) about; on 13th February a flock of six was noted.
