*Bird Notes.*

In the first week of August, at Beaumont, a Horsfield Bronze Cuckoo (*Chalcites basalıs*) was heard calling many "Seeyous" at 11 p.m. It was heard later on in the night and the first thing next morning.

Mr. A. J. Quarrell, of Westbourne Park, reports that in July, 1929, he found that the young goldfish which were in tubs sunk in his garden, and were about an inch in length, were gradually disappearing.
