*Bird Notes.*

Broad-billed Prion (*Pachyptila vittata*).—A bird sent to the South Australian Museum by Mr. E. A. Brooks was blown into the homestead at "Buckland Park" on Wednesday, 13th August, 1930, but died during the night. The homestead is three miles from the seashore, and the wind on that date was at times over 50 miles per hour. ♀, total length 25.7 cm., spread 60.3 cm., weight 2 15-16 oz., iris brown; bill, maxilla-nasal tubes black, central ridge base black, point blue, lateral plates black at base and fading to blue on edges and at apex, mandible blue; legs light blue; feet light blue, webs grey, nails horn colour tipped black; inside mouth whitish. The tongue is very large, with a pointed tip.
