*Bird Notes.*

Emu (*Dromains novae-hollandiae*).—Mr. H. M. Hale, Director of the S.A. Museum, advised that on 26th February, 1932, he saw nine Emus along the Coorong. Just about two miles east of the Causeway a flock consisting of one adult and

six young, three-fourths grown, were met with. These were feeding at the side of the road. On the pipeclay beach were two adults which showed no particular fear of the motor-car, and did not run even when the horn was sounded. All the birds seemed very dark on the heads, and the necks were a rich dark brown color.
