Notes from Woodside.—Mr. M. W. Mules wrote on 27th April, 1932:—"On 20th April I noticed a male Flame Robin (*Petroica phoenicea*), the first time I have seen this species in this locality. It was being pursued by a Scarlet Robin (*P. multicolor*), which seemed very agitated and anxious to rout the Flame Robin. Adelaide Rosellas (*Platycercus adelaidae*) have been very severe on the apples this season. Brush Wattle-Birds (*Anthochaera chrysoptera*) were also noticed eating apples, but they are not as destructive as the Rosellas."
