By Mr. F. E. Parsons.—In the second week of March he found near Salisbury a nest of the Noisy Miner (*Myzantha melanocephala*) containing three eggs. During May a Horsfield Bronze Cuckoo (*Chalcites basalis*) was heard at Glen Osmond. On 3rd June, about 4.45 p.m., he saw a flock of 44 Galahs (*Kakatoe roseicapilla*) near the south-eastern corner of the City Park Lands.
