

*Bird Notes.*

A. F. Austin, "Lake Midgeon," Narrandera, N.S.W., mentioned that the first nest he had found this season was that of a Wedge-tailed Eagle (*Uroaetus audax*) with a well-marked pair of eggs, on 23rd July, 1932. Last year the first nest found was on 25th May, 1931, and belonged to a pair of Yellow-tailed Thornbills (*Acanthiza chrysorrhoa*). He thought that the severity of the present winter had a lot to do with the lateness of the breeding season.
