Brown Songlark (*Cinclorhamphus cruralis*).—The first appearance of this species for this season on the Adelaide Plains was noted on 23rd July, 1932, by J. Neil McGilp, at Grange. F. B. Shoobridge, at Cheltenham Racecourse, and J. Sutton, at Outer Harbour. At the last-named place the species was seen or heard on a number of dates from 8th August, 1931, to 20th February, 1932.
