S. E. Terrill reports that on the Clarendon Ridge, south-east of the Happy Valley Reservoir, he saw a Yellow-winged Honey-eater's (*Meliornis novae-hollandiae*) nest with two eggs early in April, 1932, and on 14th June, 1932, a nest of the Yellow-winged Honeyeater with two eggs, and a nest of the Red Wattle-Bird (*Anthochaera carunculata*) with three eggs.
