*Bird Notes.*

16th and 17th April, 1933.—The following species were noted on the swamps in the River Murray, two to three miles north of Tailem Bend:—Black-tailed Native-Hens (*Tribonyx ventralis*), a few hundreds; many Coots (*Fulica atra*); some Grebes (*Podiceps* sp.); a dozen or more Cormorants; four Pelicans (*Pelecanus conspicillatus*); about 12 White Ibis (*Threskiornis molucca*); about 30 Straw-necked Ibis (*T.*

*spenicollis*); four White Egrets (*Egretta alba*); six Black Swans (*Chenopsis atrata*); three flocks of some 30/40 individuals each of the Black Duck (*Anas superciliosa*); three Whistling Eagles (*Haliastur sphenurus*); many Reed Warblers (*Acrocephalus australis*).
