

*Bird Notes.*

There are several varieties of waterfowl on the backwaters at present, more Musk Ducks (*Biziura lobata*) than I have ever seen before. I saw several Black-shouldered Kites (*Elanus axillaris*) here last week, also several White Herons (=Egrets sp.) and one Brolga or Native Companion (*Grus rubicundus*). This last has been here "on his own" for years, I suppose it is the same one, as the bird is always about the same locality.
