### MONTHLY MEETINGS.

There was no meeting held in December, 1933.

#### —January, 1934.—

The monthly meeting was held at the Royal Society's Rooms on Friday evening, 26th January, 1934, at 8 p.m. The Vice-President (Mr. F. E. Parsons) was in the chair.

Subjects.—Mr. F. E. Parsons exhibited some specimens of birds from Victoria recently presented to him. The Hon. Secretary then spoke briefly on the Swifts, Swallows, and Martins recorded in and near to Australia, showing specimens from the collection of the South Australian Museum.

#### —February, 1934.—

The monthly meeting was held at the usual place and time on Friday, 23rd February, 1934. The Vice-President was in the chair.

Subject.—The Hon. Secretary read to members a paper on the Longevity of Birds—Australian species, and species that had been introduced into or had been kept in captivity in South Australia. The particulars were drawn from records in the South Australian Museum, and from volumes of "The Ibis" and the Proceedings of the Zoological Society, London.
