*Bird Notes.*

On 5th February, 1934, he saw, at 7 a.m. near Meningie, a Raven (*Corvus coronioides*) and a Wedge-tailed Eagle (*Uroaetus audax*) eating a dead rabbit on the roadside. They were both feeding quietly, and did not seem to resent each other's company. At 2 p.m. on the same day, two finely-plumaged Emus (*Dromaius novae-hollandiae*) were seen along the Coorong, about 15 miles beyond Salt Creek, toward Kingston.
