There are several pairs of the Blue-faced Honeyeaters (*Entomyzon cyanotis*) around my home, and they come every morning for a feed of jam. The Red-capped Robins (*Petroica goodenovii*) have reared three young this season. They were on the wing on 3rd September. Magpies (*Gymnorhina*) are sitting, and several insect-eating birds are building. Black Duck (*Anas superciliosa*) and Teal (*Querquedula* sp.) are scarce here up to date.
