

Bird Notes.

Notes from Nargultie, near Streaky Bay, West Coast, S.A. By
H. H. Howard. 25th November, 1934.

Leptolophus hollandicus, Cockatoo-Parrot.—These Parrots are common in the district at the present time, previously they were rare visitors.

Neophema sp.—On a recent visit to Point Brown these Parrots were not seen, although from information obtained they appear to visit that locality frequently.

Bird Notes.

Lalage tricolor, White-winged Triller.—This species is fairly common at the present time.

Drymodes brunneopygia, Southern Scrub-Robin.—These shy birds are present in the scrubs, but only fleeting glances can be obtained of them.

Artamus personatus, Masked Wood-Swallow.—This annual visitor was seen this year for a longer period and in greater numbers than usual.

Neositta pileata, Black-capped Sittella.—A party of seven birds of this species visited us during the month of June.
