Outer Harbor Notes.

Mr. E. Ali reported that he had seen two Black Cormorants (*Phalacrocorax carbo*) on 26th June, 1935, and on the same day noted a Crested Tern (*Sterna bergii*) dive down and attempt to seize a small fish from a Cormorant (sp.), which had just appeared above the surface of the water; the Cormorant dived again and the Crested Tern rose up some 15 feet and evidently watched the movements of the Cormorant, for as soon as the latter came to the surface again the Tern dived down and seized the fish. He had never seen such an occurrence before.
