On 29th November, 1935, about a dozen Australian Dotterels, *Peltohyas australis*, were seen between Winnininnie head station and the railway siding, about 182 miles direct north-east of Adelaide. During the droughty conditions in November, a ♂ and a ♀ Crested Bellbird, *Oreoica gutturalis*, inhabited the garden around the homestead at Winnininnie.
