*Bird Notes.*

7/10/1935.—We have the Blue-and-White Wrens (*Malurus cyanotus*) here all the year. I find them in the lignum bushes on the Walloway Plain, from about two miles north of the town northwards up the plain. I find the Purple-backed Wrens (*Malurus assimilis*) there, too, but in the gullies in the hills south of the town, only the Purple-backed occur. I had an interesting afternoon in the scrub south of the town on September 28, 1935. There was a good number of White-plumed Honey-eaters (*Meliphaga penicillata*) feeding mostly on the nectar of *Myoporum* blossoms. I was able to get fairly close to them, a difficult thing, as the hillsides are very rough, with loose stones.
