25/2/1936.—A Little Grebe, *Podiceps ruficollis*, was on one of the dams, but was not present next day.

26/10/1935.—At Salisbury I saw a Bourke Parrot, *Neophema bourki*, flying around on my father's property. I inquired around the township, but none of its aviculturists had lost any, although one of them had seen a pair of these Parrots about a few days previously; presumably they had escaped from captivity. I wonder whether unprotected they could weather a winter out as far south as that place.
