The appearances of five of the Cuckoos—Pallid (*Cuculus pallidus*), Fan-tailed (*Cacomantis flabelliformis*), Horsfield Bronze (*Chalcites basalis*), Golden Bronze (*Lamprococcyx plagosus*), and Channel-billed (*Scythrops novae-hollandiae*)—have been reported up to date as follows:—(The other Cuckoo found in South Australia is the Black-eared (*Owenavis osculans*)).

A Pallid was seen at Islington on 29th July, and another was being chased by two White-plumed Honeyeaters (*Meliphaga penicillata*) at North Adelaide on 30th July. A Fan-tailed was seen in the garden at Prospect on 26th July.
