On a trip up the Torrens Gorge on 28th, 29th, 30th June, 1936, the following species were seen:—

Bronzewing (*Phaps* sp.), 3; Little Pied Cormorant (*Microcarbo melanoleucus*), 1; White-faced Heron (*Notophoxyx novae-hollandiae*), 1; Hawk sp., 1; Adelaide Rosella (*Platycercus adelaidae*), 35; Kookaburra (*Dacelo gigas*), 5; Welcome Swallow (*Hirundo neoxena*), 15; Fairy Martin (*Hylochelidon ariel*), 5; Willie Wagtail (*Rhipidura leucophrys*), 2; Scarlet Robin (*Petroica multicolor*), 2; Hooded Robin (*Melanodryas cucullata*), 1; Yellow-tailed Thornbill (*Acanthiza chrysorrhoa*), 2; Superb Blue Wren (*Malurus cyaneus*), 21; Singing Honeyeater (*Meliphaga virescens*), 1; White-plumed Honeyeater (*M. penicillata*), 20; Yellow-winged Honeyeater (*Meliornis novae-hollandiae*), 3; Little Wattle Bird (*Anthochaera chrysoptera*), 2; Red-browed Finch (*Aegintha temporalis*), 5; *Corvus* sp., 22 in a flock; White-backed Magpie (*Gymnorhina hypoleuca*), 16.
