At Coromandel Valley on 29th June—Eastern Shrike-Tit (*Falcunculus frontatus*); Regent Honeyeater (*Zanthomiza phrygia*); Tawny-crowned Honeyeater (*Gliciphila melanops*). Two nests of the Yellow-winged Honeyeater (*Meliornis novae-hollandiae*) were found, one containing two eggs and the other two callow young two or three days old.

At Slape's Gully on 11th July a Diamond Firetail (*Zonae-ginthus guttatus*) was noted.
