Bird Notes.

On 25th December, 1936, a flock of six Sharp-tailed Sandpipers ($Erolia\ acuminata$) was seen at the mouth of the River

Finniss into Lake Alexandrina. On 29th December, 1936, in the Coorong channel, about three miles east of the Murray Mouth, 23 Eastern Curlews (*Numenius cyanopus*) and two flocks of Sharp-tailed Sandpipers, 6 and 15 respectively, were noted.

On 14th February, 1937, four Black-shouldered Kites (Elanus axillaris) were seen on Reedy Island (No. 2), Lake Alexandrina.
