On the 11th September, 1937, nine Horsfield Bushlarks (*Mirafra javanica*) were seen and heard singing in the paddocks at the top of Tapley's Hill. Twelve Brown Songlarks (*Cincloramphus cruralis*) were seen and heard at Tapley's Hill. Two European Skylarks (*Alauda arvensis*) were heard singing near the golf links along Hallett's Cove Road. A White-breasted Cormorant (*Phalacrocorax fuscescens*) was found dead on the beach at Hallett's Cove.
