

### Locality Records.

Within the past ten years the writer has paid visits to several parts of the State for purposes other than bird observation, and on these trips notes were made on some of the species seen. Believing that the observations will interest other bird-lovers, the writer has collected these scattered notes and arranged them for publication:—

*Coturnix pectoralis*, Stubble Quail.—Numerous at Greenock in some seasons. Noted also at Auburn and Tanunda. *Phaps chalcoptera*, Common Bronzewing.—Observed nesting at Tanunda. Seen at Auburn, Greenock, Kapunda, Light's Pass, and Saddleworth. *Ocyphaps lophotes*, Crested Pigeon.—At Auburn and Greenock. *Lobibyx novae-hollandiae*, Spur-winged Plover.—At the Wakefield River, south-west of Auburn, in 1935. *Zonifer tricolor*, Banded Plover.—At Greenock. *Notophoxyx novae-hollandiae*, White-faced Heron.—At Angaston, Auburn, Greenock, Light's Pass. *Notophoxyx pacifica*,

White-necked Heron.—One near Auburn in 1932. *Circus approximans*, Swamp Harrier.—A nest containing four eggs in an advanced stage of incubation was found in Common Reeds (*Phragmites communis*) in water in the bed of the Wakefield River, south-west of Auburn, on 1st November, 1936. One of the birds flushed from the nest. \**Accipiter cirrocephalus*, Collared Sparrowhawk.—At Greenock and Tanunda. *Haliaeetus sphenurus*, Whistling Eagle.—At Auburn and Saddleworth. *Elanus axillaris*, Black-shouldered Kite.—One observed near Greenock on 18th September, 1933. *Falco hypoleucus*, Grey Falcon.—One sitting on a telegraph pole between Marrabel and Saddleworth on 17th November, 1935. *Falco subniger*, Black Falcon.—One flying between Marrabel and Saddleworth on 17th November, 1935. *Falco cenchroides*, Nankeen Kestrel.—At Auburn, Eudunda, Freeling, Greenock, Kapunda, Roseworthy and Tanunda. *Ninox boobook*, Boobook Owl.—At Greenock and Point Pass. *Glossopsitta concinna*, Musk Lorikeet, and *G. porphyrocephala*, Purple-crowned Lorikeet.—Both species were seen at Auburn, Gawler, Greenock, Point Pass, and Tanunda. *Kakatoe roseicapilla*, Galah.—At Auburn, Nuriootpa, Tanunda, and Tarnma. *Leptolophus hollandicus*, Cockatoo Parrot.—Between Auburn and Saddleworth in 1935. *Platycercus adelaidae*, Adelaide Rosella.—At Auburn, Eudunda, Gawler, Greenock, Kapunda, Point Pass, Saddleworth, and Tanunda. *Barnardius barnardi*, Mallee (Ringneck) Parrot.—At Australia Plain, Frankton, Neale's Flat, and Point Pass. *Psephotus haematonotus*, Red-backed Parrot.—At Auburn, Eudunda, Greenock, Kapunda, Point Pass, Saddleworth, and Tanunda. *Psephotus haematogaster*, Blue Bonnet.—At Australia Plain and Point Pass. *Podargus strigoides*, Tawny Frogmouth.—At Neale's Flat and Point Pass. *Dacelo gigas*, Kookaburra.—At Auburn, Greenock, and Tanunda. *Chalcites basalis*, Horsfield Bronze Cuckoo.—At Auburn on 17th November, 1935. *Hirundo neoxena*, Welcome Swallow.—At Auburn, Clare, Eudunda, Gawler, Greenock, Light's Pass, Tanunda, and Truro. *Hylochelidon ariel*, Fairy Martin.—At Auburn and Gawler. *Rhipidura leucophrys*, Willie Wagtail.—At Auburn, Clare, Eudunda, Greenock, and Tanunda. *Microeca fascians*, Jacky Winter.—At Auburn, Greenock, and Point Pass. *Petroica multicolor*, Scarlet Robin, and *P. goodenovii*, Red-capped

Robin.—Both species were seen at Greenock, Light's Pass, and Tanunda. *Pachycephala rufiventris*, Rufous Whistler.—At Light's Pass and Tanunda. *Colluricincla harmonica*, Grey Shrike Thrush.—At Auburn, Greenock, and Tanunda. *Grallina cyanoleuca*, Magpie-Lark.—At Auburn, Eudunda, Greenock, Kapunda, Light's Pass, Saddleworth, Tanunda, and Truro. *Coracina novae-hollandiae*, Black-faced Cuckoo-Shrike.—At Auburn, Greenock, and Tanunda. *Pomatostomus superciliosus*, White-browed Babbler.—At Auburn, Greenock, Kapunda, and Tanunda. *Epthianura albifrons*, White-fronted Chat.—At Greenock, Light's Pass, Marrabel, and Truro. *Aphelocephala leucopsis*, Eastern Whiteface.—At Greenock and Tanunda. *Acanthiza nana*, Little Thornbill.—At Greenock and Point Pass. *Acanthiza chrysorrhoa*, Yellow-tailed Thornbill.—At Auburn, Eudunda, Gawler, Greenock, Kapunda, Light's Pass, and Tanunda. *Cinclorhamphus cruralis*, Brown Songlark.—At Auburn, Eudunda, Greenock, Kapunda, Roseworthy, and Tanunda. *Acrocephalus australis*, Reed-Warbler.—Eight birds in Common Reeds growing in water in the Wakefield River, south-west of Auburn, on 17th November, 1935. Five birds at the same place on 1st November, 1936, and an empty nest. *Artamus cyanopterus*, Dusky Wood-Swallow.—At Greenock in 1936. *Climacteris picumnus*, Brown Tree-creeper.—At Greenock and Tanunda. *Pardalotus ornatus*, Red-tipped Pardalote.—At Gawler, Greenock, Light's Pass, and Tanunda. *Zosterops halmaturina*, Grey-backed Silvereye.—At Greenock and Tanunda. *Zanthomiza phrygia*, Regent Honeyeater.—Two birds at Mr. T. W. Zacher's home, Auburn, on 17th November, 1935. *Meliphaga virescens*, Singing Honeyeater.—At Buchanan, Eudunda, Greenock, Light's Pass, and Tanunda. *Meliphaga penicillata*, White-plumed Honeyeater.—At Auburn, Eudunda, Gawler, Greenock, Nuriootpa, and Tanunda. *Meliornis novae-hollandiae*, Yellow-winged Honeyeater.—At Greenock, Light's Pass, and Tanunda. *Myzantha melanocephala*, Noisy Miner.—At Auburn, Buchanan, Clare, Freeling, Gawler, Greenock, Kapunda, Light's Pass, Roseworthy, and Sandy Creek. *Myzantha flavigula*, Yellow-throated Miner.—Five birds in trees in Barwell Street, Eudunda, on 27th October, 1936. *Anthochaera chrysoptera*, Little Wattle-Bird.—At Tanunda in 1928. *Anthochaera carunculata*, Red Wattle-Bird.—At Gawler, Greenock, Light's Pass, and Tanunda. *Acanthagenys rufogularis*, Spiny-cheeked Honeyeater.—At Greenock and Tanunda. *Anthus australis*, Pipit.—At Auburn, Greenock, and Tanunda. *Zonae-ginthus guttatus*, Diamond Firetail.—At Eudunda, Greenock, and Tanunda. *Taeniopygia castanotis*, Zebra Finch.—At
