Fan-tailed Cuckoo (*Cacomantis flabelliformis*).

Taken at Adelaide in August, 1912 (F. R. Zietz).—Sixteen hairy caterpillars, or heads of same.

Taken at Launceston, Tas., in October, 1910.—Thirteen heads of the very destructive grass grub (*Oncoptera intricata*).—Three timber-destroying beetles (*Lepispilus sulcicollis*).

Pipit (*Anthus australis*).

Taken at Pinnaroo in September, 1912 (E. Ashby).—Blowfly (*Calliphora*); sugar ant (*Camponotus*); ant (*Iridomyrmex*); grain.

Taken at Launceston, Tas., in October, 1910.—Blowfly (*Calliphora*); moth; falcis of spider; beetle (*Adelium* ?). Many unidentifiable fragments.

Taken on Flinders Island, Bass Strait, in November, 1912 (J. W. Mellor).—Bits of two weevils (*Hyphaeria*); heads of two ants (*Pheidole* (soldiers)); head of ant; millipede; young grasshopper; caterpillar; tip of abdomen of ichneumon fly; many unidentifiable fragments; seed; some sand and small pebbles.

Spine-tailed Swift (*Hirundapus caudacutus*).

Four birds taken at Swansea, Tas., in March, 1908.—Twenty-seven destructive weevils (*Gonipterus*); two jewel beetles (*Melobasis*); one leaf-eating beetle (*Paropsis parosa* Er.); two leaf-eating beetles (*Paropsis*); one leaf-eating beetle (*Paropsis orphana* Er.); two grass-eating beetles (*Chalcolcompra*); four plant bugs (*Pentatomidae*); one plant bug (*Lygaeidae*); one bark beetle (*Sarothroerepis corticalis*); three small bees (*Apidae*); one small bee ? (*Hymenoptera*); six hive bees (*Apis mellifica*); twenty-three native bees (*Exoneura*); five flying ants (*Formicidae*); one jumper ant (*Myrmecia*); one giant thrip (*Idolothrips spectrum* H); one spiny-legged fly (Family ?); one hover fly (*Syrphidae*); one dung beetle (*Proctammodes sculptus* H.); four ichneumon flies (*Ichneumonidae*).

A bird taken in Tasmania in May, 1911.—One destructive beetle (*Gonipterus*); and forty-three hive bees (*Apis mellifica*).
