12th May, 1938.—A Beautiful Firetail (*Zonaeginthus bellus*) at Morialta. 18th May.—A dozen Regent Honeyeaters (*Zanthoniza phrygia*) in the National Park, Belair, and on 24th May a few of this species were seen at Waterfull Gully, Burnside, as well as a flock of nine or ten Swift Parrots (*Lathamus discolor*); these were quietly feeding on the flowering gumtrees. Their calls when in flight were soft.
