At Buckland Park on 29th September, 1938, nests containing eggs were seen of the Australian Coot (*Fulica atra*); Dusky Moorhen (*Gallinula tenebrosa*), and White-faced Heron (*Notophoxyx novae-hollandiae*). Several Marsh-Crakes (*Porzana pusilla*) were observed. White-headed Stilts (*Himantopus leucocephalus*) were in large flocks, and numbers of Sharp-tailed Sandpipers (*Erolia acuminata*) were about. A Yellow-billed Spoonbill (*Platalea flavipes*) was seen carrying sticks—this is the first record of this species for this locality.
