

BIRD NOTES

ENCOUNTER BAY NOTES.

A pair of Brown Songlarks (*Cinclorhamphus cruralis*) was seen at Encounter Bay on 13 December, 1940. A Reed Warbler (*Acrocephalus australis*) was heard at the mouth of the Inman River, Encounter Bay, on the same day. One Cape Barren Goose was also seen on the shore reef near the Bluff. Fork-tailed Swifts (*Macropus pacificus*) were seen on 3 January, 1942, after phenomenal duststorms of the previous day, when gusts of wind reached 72 m.p.h.
