

BIRD NOTES

A blackbird was heard singing on May 23, 1942, and also a few days previously.

Domestic pigeons have apparently established themselves at the Bluff, near Victor Harbour. (May, 1941.)

Tree swallows (*Petrochelidon arborea*) were inspecting holes in trees at Victor Harbour on May 3, 1941, and on May 4 welcome swallows, galahs, and *Cincloramphos cruralis* were noted there.—J. B. Cleland.
