

BIRD NOTES

Birds at Salisbury and Dry Creek.—On February 24 and 25, 1943, about a dozen White-headed Stilts were seen at Kilburn and seven at Dry Creek. There were also Double-banded Dotterels and numerous Silver Gulls at both places. A female or immature Grey Butcher-bird was observed on May 24 and two Wedge-tailed Eagles on May 27. On May 29, a pair of Grey Fan-tails and a male Rufous Whistler were noticed. A Golden Whistler was seen on July 5, 6, and 7, and a Fan-tailed Cuckoo on July 14.—A. O. Crompton.
